Pre-registration & Opting Out

Pre-registration for the extracurricular activities for the academic year 2022-2023 will be done online during the month of July 2022 until **31 July** using this [form](#). You will have to fill in one form per student.

The pre-registration will not be finalised until you click on the “Send” button at the end of the form (you will see that it is made up of several pages) and pay a deposit of 30€ to the AFA account for each activity selected. In other words, if you have chosen 2 activities, you will have to make a deposit of 60€.

At the end of the form you will be sent your answers and you will be able to edit them while the form is still open. That’s why in the first question we ask for your email address.

You will see that before the name of each activity there are some numbers. These digits are the codes that, together with your child’s name, you will have to mark as “concept” when you make the payment.

Therefore, if you would like to pre-register for Body in Movement and Chess you will have to make a deposit of 60€ to the account number of AFA Escola Auditori: **ES41 3025 0002 4514 3342 7815** (Caixa d’Enginyers) and put as concept: **Name Surname 03-04**.

Above all, **be sure to pay a deposit for each child**.

The deposit

You will only have to pay the deposit when pre-registering for the activities of the 1st term this will not be necessary for the 2nd and 3rd terms).

The deposit is non-refundable and will be deducted from the first payment of the extracurricular activities 2022-2023. It will only be refunded if you have been left out of the selected activity (see section “**Allocation of places**”) and you do not wish to enrol your child in any other extracurricular activity.

Allocation of places

At the end of August/beginning of September (when those of us from the *Comissió d'Extraescolars* will be back from holidays) we will take all the information from the forms, the deposits made and we will form the groups.

We will not consider or include the responses in any form that does not have the corresponding deposit.

If an activity has more registrations than places, AFA member families will have priority for places. If this is the case, we will contact the families to:

- Offer a change of group (if the activity takes place on different days of the week).
- Offer a change of activity.
- Draw lots for the available places among the children who have signed up.

In case of being left out of the draw you will be offered the possibility of:

- Do the same activity at another time (if possible).
- Choose another activity (if there are places available).
- Unsubscribe if there is no other activity that interests you. In this case the 30€ deposit will be refunded.

Second round

Once the groups are organised, we will send an email to all families with the available slots, thus opening a second round of registration. In this case it is not necessary to pay a deposit of 30€ per activity. If there are more children than places available, the procedure explained in the previous point (**Allocation of places**) will be followed.

Registration and cancellations

Towards the end of the 1st and 2nd term, you will receive an email from us informing you of the registration and cancellation period for the following term's activities. If you do not unsubscribe, we will assume that you wish to continue the activity for another term. No registrations or cancellations will be accepted outside the established period.

If any family wishes to cancel their registration before the start of the course and after having made the pre-registration and payment, they can do so before the **5th of September**, but the 30€ deposit will not be refunded. This is super important, and no exceptions will be made.

Payments

Payment for extracurricular activities is made each school term and by direct debit, although there is the option of paying in two instalments. In the case of payment by instalments, payment will be made by bank transfer within the deadlines established by *Tresoreria*.

“Before passing the bank order, *Tresoreria* will send an email informing of the exact charging date. This email will inform you of the procedure and timetable for payment in instalments. If you have any doubts, please contact tresoreria@afaescolaauditori.org.

The payment of the extracurricular activities for the 1st term will be reduced by the 30€ per activity that you have paid as a deposit during pre-registration. In the event that we do not have your bank details (because you are a new family at the school, because you were not a member of the AFA before, or for whatever reason), *Tresoreria* will contact you.

If you are an AFA member family you will enjoy a 5€ discount per activity per month, 15€ per term.

Grants

We are working to offer a system of grants to partially cover the cost of an activity for families who need it.

At the moment, we can guarantee 100% coverage of one extracurricular activity for the whole school year for all families who are part of the Barcelona City Council's Shock Plan.

The skateboarding activity benefits from the Barcelona City Council scholarship system. Those families who want to apply can find information on the [Barcelona City Council website](#). The call for applications is in October.

Once we settle this year's annual AFA budget, we will look into offering scholarships to as many families as we can, but we still need to work on that. We will keep you posted!

Timetables

Below you will find 2 timetables, one for the *Infantil* groups (P3 to P5) and one for the *Primaria* groups (1st and 2nd grade).

Some activities mix classes, and some take place inside the school and others outside. Some activities are offered only one day per week, while others offer more days to choose from.

Make sure you check carefully as you can only sign up for one day for each activity you choose (e.g. if you want to do Moviment Creatiu, you will have to choose the day you prefer).

Daily Functioning

For each extracurricular activity the dynamics vary a little (we have detailed them in the following pages), but they all have some points in common.

Activities at school

At 16:30h the person in charge of each extracurricular activity will go to the classrooms to pick up the children who will be doing the activity.

Before starting the extracurricular activity there are 10-15 minutes in which the children are with the person in charge of the extracurricular activity talking, anticipating what they will do that day and having a snack.

Once the activity is over, the person in charge will accompany the children to the school garden and hand them over to their families.

We will rely on the collection authorisations that you give to the school to authorise the collection of the extracurricular activities.

Chess (Escacs)

Chess is the only activity that takes place during school hours (at noon). On Mondays, instead of going to the *Jardí* before lunch, the children will be in one of the classrooms playing chess. Afterwards they will go to the dining room to have lunch with the rest of their classmates.

Extracurricular activities outside school

Climbing (Escalada)

The person in charge of the extracurricular activity will come to the classrooms to pick up the children and accompany them to the centre. a family member will be needed to walk the kids and the climbing teacher to the center. Once there, they will have a snack and start the activity. Each group of families will have to organise themselves to take turns to ensure this logistics. Each family will have to pick up their child directly from Bloc District at the established time.

Swimming class by bus

Roca Gonzalez staff will come to the classrooms to pick up the children for swimming and will group them in the dining room, where they can have a quick snack. Afterwards, they will bring the kids to the bus, which will waiting for them on Pamplona with Almogàvers Street and they will all go towards CNAB. On the way back, the bus will stop at the school (Pamplona and Almogàvers) and the staff will help the children to get off. Once everyone has got off the bus, the children will line up by the school wall to be handed over to their families in an orderly fashion.

Swimming class without bus, Multisports and Taekwondo

These children will leave the school with the rest of their classmates who are not doing extracurricular activities. Each family will be responsible for taking and collecting their child to/from the CNAB or CEM Icària, as well as setting aside time for a snack (if they wish). Families can organise to share the walk to CEM Icària for Multisports and Taekwondo, but under their own responsibility.

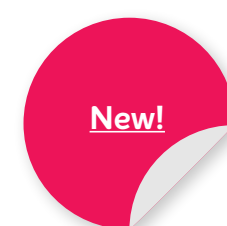

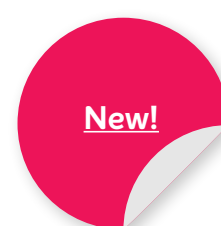

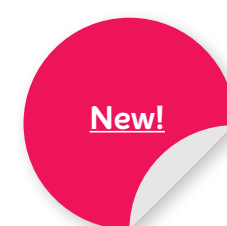

FAQs ¹/₄

Who is the person responsible for and coordinating extracurricular activities?

Although the *Comissió d'Extraescolars* is made up of mothers of students who are in charge of coordinating all the activities, from the 2022-2023 academic year on the management and coordination of the activities will be carried out by Cristina Casanova, from Roca González. You can contact her whenever you want by calling the Dining Room (**649 773 945**) or by sending an email to extraescolars@afaescolaauditori.org

How are extracurricular activities paid for?

They are paid by direct debit on a termly basis (if you change your bank details, you must inform *Tresoreria*). You can consult the payment calendar [here](#). If you wish, you can pay in two instalments. In this case, payment is made by bank transfer within the deadlines set by *Tresoreria* (see next question).

Is it possible to pay for extracurricular activities in instalments?

Yes, each term, before making the direct debit, *Tresoreria* sends an email informing of the days on which the payment by direct debit is to be made. In this email *Tresoreria* informs of the procedure and the calendar for those families who wish to pay in instalments. Can I unsubscribe from an activity in the middle of a term?

No, there are specific days to unsubscribe at the end of the term. At the end of each term we will send you an email informing you of the cancellation period.

Can I register for an activity in the middle of a term?

No, but before the beginning of the next term we will send you an email with the available places in the activities. If there are places available, we will open a registration period and you will be able to sign up.

If I have pre-registered for an activity in July and I change my mind in September, can I still unsubscribe?

Yes, as long as it is within the period established for cancellations, but in no case will the 30€ deposit be refunded.

FAQs ²/₄

Does the order of pre-registration give priority when it comes to having a place?

No. If more applications are received than places available, a draw will be made among all the families who have pre-registered, giving priority to AFA families.

What happens if I am left out of the draw?

If you are left without a place, you will be offered the possibility of choosing between the remaining activities with available places. If you have chosen other activities for which you do have a place, you will be offered the possibility of changing the days for better family management.

Is there a second round?

Yes, if there are still places available in any activity, families will be informed in case they want to register their son or daughter.

Are there scholarships / grants?

Yes, we are working on the scholarships, we will inform you as soon as we have clear criteria for access. You can find more information on the [Grants](#) page.

Can I sign my child up for the same activity several days a week?

No, you have to choose one day per activity.

What happens if a class is cancelled at the last minute?

If an activity is cancelled at the last minute (because the teacher of the activity is ill, for example), a free *Acollida* (paid for by the AFA) will be opened for the children. Families will also be notified immediately by email and/or whatsapp to the class-group and will be given the option to pick them up at the school at the time of their choice (before 17:30h).

And if the class is cancelled, do we get a refund?

No. The price for the term is fixed and there is no refund for cancelled days (regardless of the reason for cancelling - sickness of the teacher, or school holiday). If there were more than one cancellation in the same semester, we would look for a way to compensate the loss, either economically or programming an extra class on another date or online.

Can I unsubscribe if my child/children go to the swimming pool by bus?

The price of the bus is divided between all the families who use this service and you can only cancel if there are other families who want to sign up for the next term (which usually happens).

Can I pick up my child directly from the CNAB if he/she normally goes by bus?

You can only do this if you have previously informed the coordinator (**649 773 945**) and authorised the person who will pick up your child. A whatsapp is enough, but above all, don't forget to indicate the name and year of the child and the name of the person who will pick them up. **IN NO CASE SHALL AN**

INFANT BE RELEASED WITHOUT PRIOR NOTICE AND AUTHORISATION

(yes, we say it in capital letters, bold and underlined, and because we can't put coloured lights, otherwise we would!).

Do children who go to the swimming pool by bus have time for a snack?

Children who go to swimming class with the bus have very little time. They can have a quick snack before hopping on the bus, as long as it is a very simple one. We would recommend a banana or some nuts.

What should I do if my child gets sick at the last minute, or if he/she will not be attending the activity for whatever reason?

Send a whatsapp to the coordinator's phone number (**649 773 945** - keep this number on your mobile phone or write it down on your fridge!)

Can I directly contact the people in charge of the activities?

In the pdf of the information of the activities you will find either websites with contact links or e-mails to write directly to the people in charge of the activities. In case nothing appears, you can talk to the teachers who are responsible for the activities when you pick up the kids from the activities and, if the activity takes place outside the school and you have no way of contacting anyone, write to extraescolars@afaescolaauditori.org.

Will I receive a report on the activity my child is doing?

That will depend on each case, because it is the companies that decide how each activity is monitored.

Why don't I receive emails about extracurricular activities?

As an AFA we can only send emails to those families that are members and have provided us their contact information.

So first make sure that you are a member of the AFA and that your membership fee is up to date.

If you are already a member, check your spam and promotions folders, sometimes they get stuck there.

If you still don't receive any mail from us, please send an email to extraescolars@afaescolaauditori.org with CC to hola@afaescolaauditori.org so that you can be added to the mailing list.

To prevent this from happening again, please save our email as a contact so that subsequent emails will be sent to your inbox.

Why do you ask us for image rights?

At the end of the term, most companies send photographs or videos to the families who do that activity as a summary of what has been done. That is why, as it is a file where your child can be seen, we need your permission.

When you fill in the pre-registration form, you can choose the option of transferring the rights that you feel most comfortable with. If you do not give us the image rights, your child will not be included in any graphic document. If at any time you would like to change your choice of image rights, you can do so by sending us an email to extraescolars@afaescolaauditori.org
